




Installation Instructions

- Install the windshield as shown. Fasten the straps on the windshield to the clamp assembly (3). Buckle lower windshield clamps to ROPS tube.
- Make sure lower seal has good contact with cowl surface.

• Install lower retaining bracket (11) using bolt (7) and collar (14). Two places.



- Loosen and adjust clamp assembly (3) as needed for final adjustment.
- Put windshield in down position. Note the location where the rubber latch strap contacts the fender. Clean the plastic in this location, and apply protective sticker (12).

WARNING

During transport of vehicle, on trailer or by another unenclosed method, the vehicle MUST be in a forward facing position with the windshield closed. Failure to orient the vehicle in a forward facing position with the windshield closed could result in the windshield detaching from the vehicle during transport.

WARNING

Drive at 50mph or less when the windshield is open, or the windshield may become detached during use, resulting in injury.
